



VIP Concierge

The Greenwich International Film Festival is seeking a customer service driven VIP Concierge to create and fulfill the VIP experience for passholders and supporters leading up to and during the festival. This position reports to the Festival Producer and Executive Director and is responsible for developing and facilitating festival benefits and activities for VIP clients. This is a paid, seasonal position for the period of April 24th to June 6th, 2018.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepare and conduct all communication with Festival passholders and VIP clients for the festival (welcome and thank you letters);
- Create schedules for VIP's to maximize their Festival experience;
- Facilitate hotel reservations as needed;
- Secure VIP parking and create passes;
- Arrange transportation as required;
- Responsible for VIP seating reservations and seating chart for all relevant festival events;
- Prepare & distribute lanyards, gift bags, etc.;
- Secure/solicit items for VIP gift bags;
- Assist in training VIP volunteers;
- Arrange special VIP activities with passholders, using festival assets such as Meet & Greet, yacht rides, special wines at venues, special check in line, etc.;
- Prepare a wrap-up report post-festival.
